WALKING BEAR COMES HOME

The Life and Work of Chuck Jonkel, A Pioneer of Bear Biology

(Monday, May 1 at 6 pm and Tuesday, May 2 at 12 pm)

After conducting the first capture-and-handling studies on black bears in Montana in 1959, Chuck Jonkel explored the Canadian Arctic pioneering the field of polar bear biology. *Walking Bear Comes Home* examines Jonkel's contributions to wildlife biology, conservation, and community through interviews and archival footage. This documentary had its premiere screening at the International Wildlife Film Festival in April.

Program Descriptions for May 1 through May 6

INDEPENDENT LENS (Mon. 1)
"National Bird" National Bird is the first in-depth investigation of the U.S. drone war with unique access to two courageous women, a drone-target analyst and a retired intelligence officer, who connect with a former NSA analyst to become whistleblowers on the drone program, risking backlash.

FRONTLINE (Tues. 2)
"Second Chance Kids" A fight over the fate of juveniles in prison for murder, following a landmark Supreme Court ruling. The film examines the impact of the order to re-evaluate thousands of juvenile murder cases and follows two of the first convicts to be released.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE (Tues. 2)
"Ripley: Believe It or Not" Robert Ripley's obsession with the odd and keen eye for the curious made him one of the most successful men in America during the Great Depression, transforming himself from a skinny loner into a flashy entertainer who presented to the nation a blend of freakish oddities, colorful exotica, and homespun Americana. This is the story of the man who popularized the iconic phrase, and proof of why we still can't resist his challenge to "Believe it — or not!"

VICTORIAN SLUM HOUSE (Tues. 2)
"The 1860s" Follow participants as they move into an 1860s tenement made up of sparse rooms, a shared water pump and outdoor privies. They seek to make a living by matchbox making, wood turning and the rag trade, work once done by their impoverished forebears.

PLANTS BEHAVING BADLY (Wed. 3)
"Murder & Mayhem" Examine the extraordinary behavior of carnivorous plants, which have been a feature of many a sci-fi film over the years. The reality turns out to be far stranger than the fiction. See why.

NOVA (Wed. 3)
"Super Tunnel" Underneath the streets of London, a team of more than ten thousand construction

workers race to build a brand new metro line—Crossrail. Costing almost \$23 billion, it's the biggest engineering project in Europe and must link into the existing metro system. Join NOVA to plunge into the tunnels of the London Underground and follow this high stakes, action packed engineering endeavor, and discover just how engineers are performing this delicate surgery through the heart of the historic city.

NATURE (Wed. 3)
"Dolphins: Spy in the Pod" The camera eyes of 13 ingenious Spy Creatures, including Spy Dolphin, Spy Nautilus and Spy Turtle, capture the dolphins' "superpod" behavior never filmed before. Infiltrate the social world of dolphins from strange gatherings to gang rivalries.

THE THIS OLD HOUSE HOUR (Thurs. 4)
Rough wiring is installed in the kitchen. A new HVAC system goes in. Tommy installs new fascia. On ASK THIS OLD HOUSE, Scott installs a portable generator to power a house in Alaska and Tom repairs wood floor nosing.

ANTIQUES ROADSHOW (Thurs. 4)
"Virginia Beach" Join ROADSHOW to visit Virginia Beach. Featured finds include a 1964 Cassius Clay twice-signed promotional print, modern Abdullah Qandeel "Red" and "Love" oils, and an early 18th-century Chinese celadon vase. Which is valued at \$50,000-\$80,000?

HOME FIRES ON MASTERPIECE (Thurs. 4)
Steph risks losing the farm. Sarah finds herself in a dangerous situation, while Teresa has a big decision to make. Alison discovers the real reason behind the parachute accidents, but can she warn Frances before it's too late?

LATIN MUSIC USA (Fri. 5)
"The Chicano Wave/Divas and Superstars" Learn how music played an important role in the struggle for Chicano civil rights, and review the impact of the Latin pop explosion of

the turn of the 21st century.

THIS OLD HOUSE (Sat. 6)
"Detroit / Fixing the Fascia" Rough wiring is installed in the kitchen. A new HVAC system goes in. Richard heads to Flint, MI, to learn about their ongoing water crisis. Back at the house, Tommy installs new fascia.

MARTHA STEWART'S COOKING SCHOOL (Sat. 6)

Then, is this a hand-drawn map of Valley Forge that George Washington used during the American Revolution? And does a Tucson man own one of the first transistor radios ever made? Finally, after 70 years, a Washington man wonders whether a business card ties his father to Prohibition-era underworld crime.

THE GREAT BRITISH BAKING SHOW (Sat. 6)
"Masterclass 1" Mary and Paul take over the tent for the ultimate baking masterclass, making Mary's whole orange cake and angel food cake, Paul's breakfast muffins and olive bread sticks, and the duo's showstopper chocolate cake.

Program Descriptions for May 7 through May 13

CALL THE MIDWIFE (Sun. 7)
Valerie Dyer oversees the care of an expectant Somali woman and is shocked when she uncovers a troubling aspect of this unfamiliar culture. The Nonnatus family unites to provide the very best care for Sister Mary Cynthia.

MASTERPIECE (Sun. 7)
"Home Fires" (Pt. 6) There's cause for joy in the village as everyone prepares for a wedding. Even as the allies cheer for victory in the Battle of Britain, there's one more twist of fate in store for the citizens of Great Paxford.

MASTERPIECE (Sun. 7)
"Wolf Hall" Henry's love for Anne Boleyn has given way to anger and distrust. Henry instructs Cromwell to rid him of his second queen. Sensing her loss of favor, the queen's enemies gather.

INDEPENDENT LENS (Mon. 8)
"The Prison in Twelve Landscapes"
More people are imprisoned in the United States at this present moment than in any other time or place in history, yet prisons themselves have never felt further away or more out of sight. The Prison in Twelve Landscapes is a film about the prison in which we never see an actual penitentiary. A meditation on the prison's disappearance in the era of mass incarceration, the film unfolds as a cinematic journey through a series of ordinary places across the USA where prisons affect lives.

ANTIQUES ROADSHOW (Mon. 8)
"Corpus Christi" Notable stories include a guest who met the Beatles and walked away with John Lennon's signature and another who encountered Salvador Dali on one of his frequent visits to Manhattan and left with a book inscribed by the artist, valued at \$10,000 to \$15,000.

FRONTLINE (Tues. 9)
"Poverty, Politics and Profit"
Investigate the billions spent on housing the poor and why so few get the help they need. With NPR, the film examines the politics, profits and

problems of an affordable housing system in crisis.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE (Tues. 9)
"Bonnie and Clyde" In the spring of 1934, throngs of onlookers flocked to two Dallas funeral homes hoping to catch a last glimpse of the famous outlaws Clyde Barrow and Bonnie Parker. For over two years, the country had been transfixed by their illicit romance and a violent crime spree that left a trail of dead bodies in its wake. In the years since their deaths, dozens of movies, documentaries and television series have been made glamorizing the lives and deaths of Bonnie and Clyde.

VICTORIAN SLUM HOUSE (Tues. 9)
"The 1870s" Witness a dire economic depression heightened by the arrival of Irish migrants seeking work. Daily, the slum dwellers toil to fulfil clothing orders and make artificial flowers for factories. Some won't be able to settle their debts.

PLANTS BEHAVING BADLY (Wed. 10)
"Sex & Lies" Revel in the ethereal beauty of orchids and examine their exotic flowers, which are shaped for one purpose – to attract pollinators. Many use sex as a lure, impersonating a female bee or wasp.

NOVA (Wed. 10)
"Arctic Ghost Ship" 160 years ago, the Franklin Expedition to chart the Northwest Passage vanished. NOVA is on board as a Canadian team makes a breakthrough discovery of one of Franklin's lost ships—a vital new clue to the fate of the ill-starred expedition.

NATURE (Wed. 10)
"Dolphins: Spy in the Pod 2" The Spy Creatures continue to reveal the world of dolphins as never before, their mysteries of communication and strategies. Go undercover to meet the Orca, the largest dolphins, and race the Dall's porpoises, the fastest dolphins in the world.

THIS OLD HOUSE HOUR (Thurs. 11)
Tommy uses a clever fix for some

damaged oak flooring. Mark McCullough repairs the front steps. On ASK THIS OLD HOUSE, Richard uses cameras to find a drain pipe problem and Scott installs an electric convection heater.

MARTHA STEWART'S COOKING SCHOOL (Sat. 13)
"Cooking with Grains" Revive your grain game with inspiration from the Arabian Gulf. Martha re-creates a traditional savory porridge while playing with preparations for kamut and roasted vegetables, mixed-grain pilaf with chicken, and herbed barley salad with dates.

MARTHA BAKES (Sat. 13)
"White Bread" Learn how to make dough inspired by Japanese milk bread to create soft, springy-textured breads and rolls. Make a basic Japanese-style white bread loaf and two variations using the same dough: cinnamon-raisin swirl bread and jalapeno-cheddar rolls.

GREAT BRITISH BAKING SHOW (Sat. 13)
